Understand the range of Mental Health and Addiction issues and the impact on health and wellbeing for a person experiencing these issues. Understand interventions and community services available, how to communicate appropriately and apply professional, ethical practice as a Community and Mental Health Support Worker. Understand different cultural identities and culture-related issues and work collaboratively with other Healthcare professionals to achieve outcomes benefiting the client.

- Mental Health Issues include disorders of; attention, anxiety, depression, eating, personality, psychotic and the effects of co-existing conditions.
- Addictive Behaviours include; anxiety, stress, physical dependence, learned behaviour and modelling.
- Substance Addictions include; alcohol, cannabis, stimulants, depressants, opioids, hallucinogens, phencyclidines polysubstance, tobacco and withdrawal.
- Non-Substance Addictions include; gambling, internet, work, food, sex, risk-taking, shopping.

Kalandra offers the Certificate in Mental Health Support (Mental Health and Addictions) (Level 4) a 46-week, ONLINE programme designed to upskill HCA's in the specialised area of Mental Health and Addictions. Graduates will be awarded a New Zealand Certificate in Health and Wellbeing (Social and Community Services) (Level 4) with a strand in Mental Health and Addiction. Graduates will also have HCA Level 4 status and pay parity.
